I know that starting a job search in the human rights sector can be quite overwhelming and takes a lot of time and effort on your part. But don't feel daunted - let me help you. I've listed below some useful job board sites and resources which will, hopefully, provide a good starting point for you.

You'll also find details of entry-level opportunities and government-sponsored programmes in International Organizations (such as the Junior Professional Officer Program in the UN).

Many aspiring human rights professionals start their career journey by undertaking internships. Unfortunately, the human rights sector has been slow in offering paid internships. I am fundamentally opposed to this practice, and, as a result, I have only listed paid internship opportunities in this resource. I firmly believe that aspiring human rights professionals should be appropriately remunerated for their work.

Most job sites allow you to search by location, thematic area, professional level and job roles. Post-pandemic, there are now opportunities to work remotely, hybrid, or in person. This automatically opens up lots of exciting new opportunities for you so think carefully about what work might look like for you going forward!

Make sure that you sign up for personal job alerts so that you don't miss your dream job! In addition, on some job boards, you can register your CV and sign up for newsletters.

<u>EuroBrussels</u> | EuroBrussels is the leading job site for European Affairs and International Affairs positions.

<u>UN Job Net</u> | UN Jobnet is more focused on the UN and its agencies and lists all job openings in the United Nations and a few major international organizations.

<u>Impactpool</u> | Job vacancies in the European Union, United Nations, NGOs, and International Organizations. The website also has some excellent career resources, and expert tips some of which are behind a paywall.

<u>International Affairs Jobs</u> | International Affairs Job is a leading site for jobs in international affairs, NGOs, human rights, United Nations, and development aid.

<u>Human Rights Careers</u> | HRC is a platform that provides information about online courses, jobs, paid internships, master's degrees, scholarships, and other opportunities in the human rights sector and related areas.

Reliefweb | ReliefWeb is a humanitarian information service provided by the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA). It provides international job listings and training programs.

<u>UN Careers</u> | Official website for information on career paths in the UN. All FAQs on different types of contracts/positions offered within the organisation. There is also a section on tips and guidance on how to apply for available positions and interview preparation. | Official Human Resources gateway to apply for UN positions. Users need to create an account and search for roles to begin the application process.

<u>UN Volunteers</u> | UN Volunteers deploy international volunteers to the field in development programmes and peacekeeping missions. UN Volunteer assignments are advertised on the <u>Unified Volunteering Platform</u> and candidates need to register in the Global Talent Pool.
